1. Numbers are the enrollments in credit courses offered by each department. Students enrolled in library science, orientation, and women's studies courses are not reported because there is no department affiliation for those courses. Students in James Rumsey courses are not included because those are not Shepherd courses. As of Fall 2001, NCTC enrollments are excluded because Shepherd does not plan or pay for those courses. Students are duplicated.

2. Enrollments have been assigned to departments which existed in Fall 1999. For example, Environmental Studies was not a department in 1995, but enrollments in the GSCI and PHYS courses in that year are counted there; those courses subsequently became the responsibility of that department.
